Web Reporting

Advanced Pathology Laboratory offers secure web reporting for physicians. Once a report is signed off by the pathologist it can be accessed by the referring physician after logging to www.adpathlab.com. To view case reports online, you must have an authorized user log-in name and password. The user name assigned to a physician is not editable.

The web session expires after a period of inactivity, but for increased security, you should log out once you are done viewing the reports.

Case Reports Search

There are two options to search for case reports:

Pathway 1: allows you to search for reports using patient information like name, date of birth, or social security number.

Pathway 2: You can use this pathway to search for all of your cases.

Furthermore, for both pathway 1 and 2, you may specify the time range for the search, based on the date received for the cases. You may search for reports where the specimen was received within the last day, 3 days, 7 days, 2 weeks, one month, or one year. If no search criterion is entered other than the time range, a list of all cases with specimens received within that time range is displayed.

The list displays the case number, patient name, specimen/case type, date received, case status and any special status associated with the case. You may then click on the desired case number to view the report. Reports can only be viewed for signed off (verified) cases. Other cases will appear on the list, but the report will only be visible if the case has been signed off.

Please keep your user information in a safe place. Obviously if it is made available to others, they can access the confidential information of your patients.
